Happy Friday everybody. We reach the end of Summer 1 and head into the half term break ahead of the busy conclusion to the school year in June and July.

**Working Together as a Team:** Within our work on **Collaboration**, our focus Habit of Mind, we have been thinking carefully about what it means to work successfully as a team. This week we have thought about how we can't do everything by ourselves and to achieve great things we need to work with others. **Dentaid Workshops Yr R, 1, 2 and 3:** On Wednesday, children in Year R to Year 3 had special workshops delivered by the charity Dentaid about dental hygiene and health. The interactive sessions were full of helpful advice and knowledge to help children look after their teeth.

**Y5 and Y6 Art Workshops with professional artist, Amy Goodman:** On Thursday, Year 5 and 6 had the exciting opportunity to work with professional local sculptor, Amy Goldman. They created special pieces of art celebrating different moments and features of Queen Elizabeth II's reign. It was amazing to see the children's awe and wonder when appreciating Amy's artwork and being inspired to paint their own stunning masterpieces. Amy has been commissioned to create a special bronze sculpture of Queen Elizabeth II which will be located in the Abbey grounds.

**Hampshire and IOW Fire and Rescue Service** came into school today to work with Year 1 and Year 5, teaching the children about how to stay safe at home and what to do if they discover a fire.
