We are able to look after your children who attend our school (not pre-school or secondary school children) during the meeting to help enable you to attend. It would be great to see lots of you there as committee members are voted for and appointed and for as many parents as possible to get involved in lots of ways big or small. **Holocaust Memorial Day Service:** On Wednesday pupils in Year 4, 5 and 6 maturely and confidently led our annual Holocaust Memorial Day Service at the Abbey. We were joined by the Mayors of Test Valley and Romsey respectfully, who were both incredibly impressed with the children's leadership of the poignant service.

**Smart Phones:** As a school and in close collaboration with the other schools in the Romsey area, we are seeking to promote clear and healthy messages about smart phones within childhood. Rather than overwhelm you with all the ideas and information in one go, I will be adding different things each week to provoke thought and encourage healthy habits and attitudes. We believe this is a vitally important area of education and wellbeing and we wish to be proactive in giving key messages.

To begin with, we will be insisting that **children who do bring phones into school, hand them into the office as soon as they arrive in school and before they go through the green gate**. Phones should then only be collected at the end of the day from the office once the child has been dismissed by their teacher. Children will not be permitted to have phones on the school grounds. We discourage children from bringing in phones at all but we know some parents value the reassurance of their children having a phone if they are walking to and/or from school independently in Year 5 and Year 6.

**Smart Watches:** Linked to the above, smart watches are not permitted in school. Watches that have the capacity to record sound/video or take/store photographs, receive messages and link to a smart phone and/or play games should not be brought into school for very similar reasons to the phones. If we are unsure of the functions of a child's watch, teachers will ask the child to show them what it can do so we can be confident that the watch is appropriate for school. We are keen to be as consistent and fair as we can and would appreciate your support in this area.
