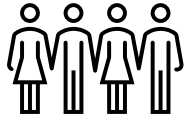


# Collective Worship Behaviour at RAPS

## Ready, Respectful, Safe

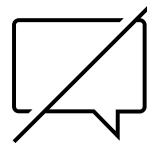
**Goal:** Collective Worship is set apart as a special and unique part of our day as a school family where we develop spiritually with open eyes, open hands, open hearts and open minds. Together we inspire one another to learn and grow as we follow in the footsteps of Jesus with Love, Trust and Forgiveness.



I know to sit where my teacher shows me and stay sat down unless invited to move



I know to enter and leave the hall silently and sensibly



I know to sit silently unless invited to move, talk or sing



I know to be whole body listening and remain respectful whether I choose to join in with the prayer or not.



I know to put my hand up to talk or get my teacher's attention

### Rewards and Recognition

I may be invited to sit on the bench if I am spotted being an excellent role model of positive behaviour and attitudes throughout Collective Worship

My class might receive a marble if we are all examples to everyone else of how to enter, sit and participate in and leave Collective Worship

House Points for thoughtful participation and respectful attitudes  
If I am being an excellent team player and role model, I am more likely to be chosen for a responsibility or as a volunteer.

### Consequences and Further Learning

An adult may instruct me to sit next to them or in a different space

An adult will talk to me to teach me what is expected behaviour in Collective Worship

An adult will ask me to practice sitting silently the following day to help me learn and remember what is expected in Collective Worship

## **Responsibilities**

### **Children:**

Learn and follow the expectations on the Behaviour Curriculum Map

Remember you can go to the toilet before or after Collective Worship but should not ask to go during it

### **Year 6:**

Be excellent examples of the expectations for Collective Worship and support the rest of the school family in learning and following those expectations

Report concerns to appropriate teacher in a sensible and respectful way after Collective Worship
