Creativity: Our focus Habit of Mind this term is Creativity, looking at how we imagine, take risks and solve problems. This week in Collective Worship we explored how sometimes we don't always see the purpose of everything we have to do or experience in the present time and it is only later when we look back we see the value of those challenges and experiences. It is usually worth sticking at those things (practising spellings, reading, tying shoe laces etc) so that we achieve and solve problems in the long run. One of the phrases in our shared language is **"Imagine what the result will be if..."** It is helpful to think about 'future us' to gain the motivation to persevere in the present.
